Furlough 2009

Heather and I are already half way through our 4th year on the mission field and what a wonderful journey it has been! We are back on the island of Puerto Rico now after a wonderful furlough. To all of you who are receiving our newsletter for the first time we would like to thank you for your interest in what God is doing through New Day Christian Ministry and to all of you who have continued to support this ministry through the years may God richly bless you and continue to make you a blessing. We would like to extend our gratitude to all of you who were so kind to us as we traveled and visited your church or stayed with you in your home. We had a busy furlough, traveling and sharing what the Lord is doing in and through New Day, and also participating in other ministry opportunities as well. While visiting our home church, Germantown Baptist Chapel, I had the privilege of leading a one week revival and also a weeklong course on witnessing entitled "Share Jesus Without Fear", (*a class I would encourage every church to teach at least once a year*). I enjoyed the blessing of leading a man to the Lord in the Hickman County Jail, and was honored to officiate the wedding of one of my former youth. We were happy to have Heather's father travel with us for a while as we took to the road to share what the Lord has been doing. It was wonderful to have him with us. During the furlough we were also able to celebrate Hannah's first Birthday, Thanksgiving, and Christmas with our family and friends. The last time we had shared Thanksgiving with our family was in 2003 before leaving for the mission field in 2004 which made this Thanksgiving a very special one for all of us. We have returned to PR refreshed and ready to continue the work the Lord has called us to do.



What If It Were Today?



I have flown too many times to count these past nine years back and forth to the States and PR. Now we have begun to fly further distances as we continue to follow the Lord's leading into these new fields of ministry He is opening to us. Flying has become a normal and necessary part of our lives. I have experienced turbulence many times as the plane would bump around a bit and I have never thought much about it. The thought that stepping onto a plane is a step of faith had not much occurred to me, that is until this last flight we had from Orlando, FL to Ponce, PR. We had already been traveling most of the day and it was around 11:00 PM when we left FL. We were all tired and Hannah fell asleep very quickly after takeoff and Heather was not too far behind her. About a third of the flight had gone smoothly when the captain came over the intercom and said that we would be going through some turbulence and we needed to put on our seat belts. A few minutes later there were a few bumps. Twenty minutes later or so while flying 30,000 feet over the Atlantic Ocean we hit more than a bump! The plane shot up sharply and then started to plummet. For a few moments the things in the cabin were floating, including me, and then thrown back down. Heather woke and began to join most of the other passengers who were already screaming. That is except for Hannah who remained asleep in her seat oblivious to the peril we were in. The plane pitched to the left and to the right, down and up, and the tail of the plain was fishtailing way left and way right. For the first time in my life I believed that I was going to be going home to my Creator very quickly and so I began to pray and to think about my life: Was I ready to meet God, had I wasted any of the time I had been given, was my work finished, was I ready to leave this world for the next? While I was looking into eternity I was at peace that me and my family would be together in heaven, and that I had lived a blessed life but I was concerned that I had not finished all the work I was called to do. I prayed, "I am ready to go if you are bringing me home. Is the work that you have given me to do finished? If you have more work for me to do I know you will bring us down safely". The rest of the flight was tense. The plain leveled off and a few more times there was turbulence that kept anyone from relaxing. When the plane was finally on the ground and stopped around 2:00 am in Ponce, PR there was a thunderous applause by all the passengers and in my heart a stronger resolve to live out my faith to the fullest as long as the Lord gives me the breath to do so.

Making The Best Use Of The Time

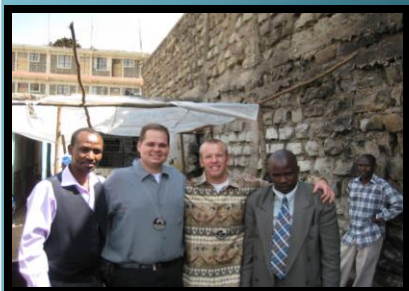
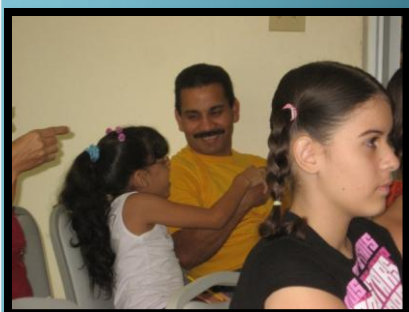

God is truly doing a great work! In just a few more months as the Lord provides we will be traveling there to continue to establish this new church and train these new leaders. While we are there we will be: training the leaders from all the groups, providing a Backyard Bible School for the children, and preaching the Gospel in evening meetings. This year there will be a team joining us. In this team so far are two members from our home church, Pastor Andy Powell and David Cowden, Heather and Hannah will also be going this year as well. David and Josh will be leaving for Africa on May 20th, 2009 ahead of the team. They will be traveling to Tanzania to help establish a New Day Christian Ministry branch there. 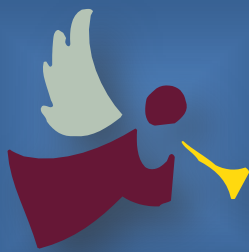

Soon after we returned from Africa and finished with Deaf Camp this past summer we were contacted by a pastor in India, Henry Devadas. He has asked that we come to preach and teach with him in India. We are planning a revival for 250 pastors and to travel with him to minister with some of those ministers. Henry also leads a children's orphanage. This Christmas we sent funds to purchase 22 of the 66 children a new pair of pants and a shirt. We still need \$200 more to be able to cloth the rest of the children. If you feel the Lord leading you to help us cloth these children please write India Orphanage in the memo of your check. What an awesome door of ministry the Lord has opened. Please join us as we pray for this upcoming ministry. David and Josh will be traveling on the last week of Oct. 2009 and returning the 4th week of November.

As the Lord has been leading us into these new areas of ministry the need for funds specifically for travel has become a fundamental need. We are praying for those who will give on a monthly bases to meet this continual need.



Bibles For Africa



We are very excited about this ministry the Lord has made possible. Through our partnership with The Bible League of Uganda we are able to make it possible for you to help place a Bible in the hands of the people of Kenya and Uganda in their languages. Since the Bibles are paid for there, the extremely high cost of shipping has been eliminated making it possible for more money to go into the actual cost of the Bible. Also everything that we give is matched by the Bible League. Everything that we receive goes directly to the cost of paying for the Bibles and is not used for any other purpose. The Bibles cost \$7 and are distributed upon completion of a foundational Bible study. Through ministry partners like you we have already been able to handout 80 Bibles! 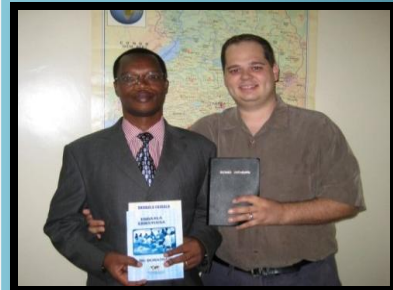

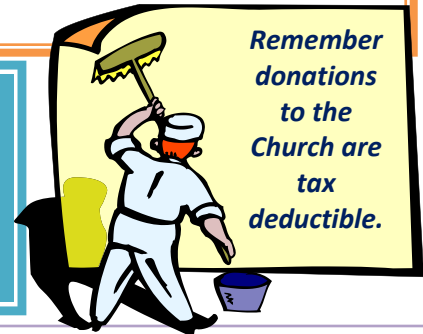
