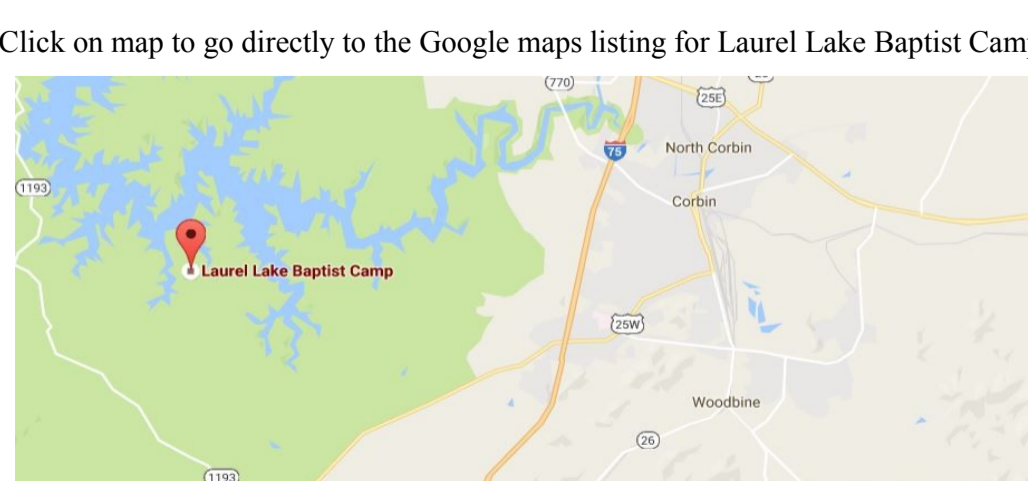
Though it would be helpful for you to preregister for the retreat as long as there is room left all are welcome to register the day of the retreat for **\$65 cash, \$68 CC**
